What Goes in Your Recycling Cart

- Cardboard:** All cardboard including flattened shipping boxes.
- Cartons:** All coated and non-coated paper cartons.
- Glass:** Food and beverage containers.
- Metal:** Aluminum and metal cans, metal lids, and aluminum foil.
- Paper:** All clean paper, junk mail and magazines, paper boxes, cardboard egg cartons, and bags.
- Plastics #1-#7:** Hard plastics such as milk jugs, juice, shampoo, detergent bottles, yogurt containers, nurse pots, and plastic toys. No plastic film or Styrofoam.

What Goes in Your Organic Waste Cart

- Grass / Landscape trimmings:** All yard waste. No dirt, sand, rocks, palm fronds, yucca or succulants.
- Wood:** (including pallets)
- Food scraps:** All food waste is accepted for recycling including: meat, bones, fish, shells, dairy, bread, fruit, vegetables, peels, pits, cobs and coffee grounds.

All food scraps must be placed in plastic or paper bags and securely tied.

What Goes in Your Trash Cart

- Non-recyclable trash:** including food wrappers, Styrofoam, diapers, hoses, pet waste, old shoes and textiles, plastic bags.
- No hazardous waste
- No batteries
- No cooking or motor oil
- No tires
- No paint
- No electronics or appliances
- No fluorescent or incandescent light bulbs
- No medical needles or sharps

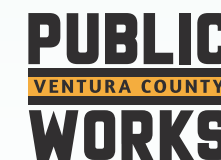

Bulky Item Service:

Single-family households subscribing to collection service receive up to two (2) bulky items picked up per calendar year at no cost. Multi-family residents (2 or more dwelling units) or mobile home park residents may receive bulky item pickup service at a cost. Please call your service provider for rates.

"Bulky items" means appliances, furniture, electronic waste, and other large, bulky items that are discarded by residential customers (excluding debris and materials from construction and demolition activities).



The County along with several jurisdictions offer free HHW collection events to UA residents. Businesses that qualify as Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQGs) may participate in most programs below for a nominal fee. Appointments required.
